

## Medical University Innsbruck

The Medical University Innsbruck (MUI) was founded in 2004 and by then has been a part of the Leopold Franzens University of Innsbruck.

The MUI is striving towards providing the highest possible quality in research, education and patient care and thereby offering excellent medical research, high quality education and training including e-learning facilities, and a Centre for High Performance Medicine.

Recent figures show 3,300 students, 280 graduates per year and 120 members of scientific and teaching staff. By October 2007, Gender-Based Medicine has been incorporated in the curriculum as a teaching subject.

Additionally, the MUI is providing lectures given by various experts in this field organised by the Unit for Gender Studies conducted by Prof. Margarethe Hochleitner, the current Vice-Rector for Human Resources, Human Resources Development and Gender Equality, who intensively promotes different projects associated with women's empowerment and support in every day child care.
