Karolinska Institutet (KI), Stockholm, is one of the top ranked medical universities in the world. The Centre of Gender Medicine is one of several research and educational centres at KI and started 2001. An international evaluation of the centre Nov 2007 was very positive. The aim of the centre is to support excellent research in the area and to teach gender medicine at all levels. The centre has 2 educational leaders.

The following courses are offered:

First level

- a) Introduction in gender medicine, first year, medical students, 0.375 ECTS,
- b) Introduction in gender medicine, second year, physiotherapy, 0.375 ECTS.

Second level

- a) Modern cardiovascular therapy, an elective course in the Study Programme for Medicine, 4.5 ECTS.,
 - b) Web based course in Gender Medicine planned to autumn 2010 ,15ECTS .c) Health and gender perspectives, 15 ECTS, planned to autumn 2010.
- Research level: a) Gender aspects in biomedical research, 1.5 ECTS, b) Gender aspects in neurology 1.5 ECTS.
